His Lordship — Somerset & At a Session of the Court of his Lordship the right Honourable Robert Geddes, the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of March toward the Seventeenth day of the same month Anno Domini thousand seven hundred and forty before his said Lordship's Justices the peace in the County aforesaid to keep signed by the Oath of twelve Jurors presented that Robert Geddes of Coventry parish for committing of waste on the Land belonging to John Worthey or about February last to the quantite of four Thousand white Oak Shives or thereabouts.

Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Robert Geddes if he should be found in his baileywick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before this Justices of his Lordship's County — Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June one thousand seven hundred and forty one to Answer unto his said Lordship of the presentment aforesaid

And now to wit the third Tuesday of June being the Sixteenth day of the same month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and forty at a Court then held at Dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid before his Lordship's Justices came as well Robert Denham Henry Gent his said Lordship's attorney who for his said Lordship in this part prosecuted as the aforesaid Robert Geddes in his proper person and hereupon the said Robert Geddes is ordered to give Recognizance in ten pounds Current money of Maryland for his appearance at the next Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer the same day is given to the aforesaid Robert Denham Henry who aforesaid.

Thereupon the said Robert Geddes present having first as the aforesaid acknowledged himself indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in ten pounds Current money of said Province of his body goods or chattels Lands or tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and levied If it happen that the said Robert Geddes do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August then next following
