Tuesday of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirtynine to answer unto Jane Bolk John Bolk and Ann Bolk
of a plea of trespass upon the afo^d: And the same day is given to the afo^d: Jane John and Ann here &c.

At which day here came the afo^d: Jane Bolk John Bolk and Ann Bolk by Robert Jenkins Henry their Attorney afo^d:
The sheriff to wit John Henry went now here returned that he had taken the afo^d: James Quatermy whose body her at this day he
had ready to answer the afo^d: Jane Bolk John Bolk and Ann Bolk of the afo^d: plea as to him it was commanded

that whereas the afo^d: James the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred thirtynine Somerset County
afo^d: was indebted to the same Jane John and Ann in the sum of fifteen pounds Current money of Maryland for the like sum of
money of the same Jane John and Ann and divers other persons to the profit and use of them the said John John & Ann by the
afo^d: James before that time had and received and so thereof indebted being the said James in consideration thereof upon himself did
assume and to the same Jane John and Ann then and there faithfully promise that he the said James the afo^d: fifteen pounds
Current money of Maryland to the afo^d: Jane John and Ann when thereof he should be requested well and faithfully would pay and
Content nevertheless the afo^d: James his promise and assumption afo^d: little regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the same
Jane John and Ann in that part craftily and suttlely to deceive and deceipt the afo^d: fifteen pounds Current money or any penny
