And further it is ordered by the Court here that a certain Mary Horsey sister to the said Sarah Horsey deliver up unto the said Hannah Turpin all the Estate of the said Sarah Horsey that she hath in her hands and of Right to belong &c.

Joshua Merrill of Somerset County Gent brings his negro boy into Court called Derry and prays the Judgment of the Court here hold on the said Derry was at this day &c. Whereupon the said negro Derry is adjudged by the Court here to be of the age Ten years &c.

His Lordship of Somerset p. Memorandum That at a Court of his Lordships the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the Province of Maryland held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday of June to witt the Tenth day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and fortyone before his said Lordships Justices the peace in the County of - to keep assigned by the Oath of twelve Jurors being presented that Elizabeth Carey late of Steprey parish in the County of - Spinster the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain person to the Jurors aforesaid unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnall knowledge of her body and then and there to beget a bastard Child on the body of her the same Elizabeth Carey to the high displeasure of Almighty God to the Evill Example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided &c.

Thereupon it is Comanded the sheriffe of the County of Somerset County that he should take the said Elizabeth Carey if she should be found in his bailiwick and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August One thousand seven hundred & fortyone to answer unto his said Lordship of the Indictment aforesaid.

Att which day here before his said Lordships Justices at a Court then held at Dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid came the aforesaid Sheriffe and returned the aforesaid precept thereof in form aforesaid to him directed and further Testified that the aforesaid Elizabeth Carey is not found in his bailiwick. Thereupon Command is as before to the aforesaid Sheriffe that he should take the aforesaid Elizabeth Carey if she should be found in his bailiwick and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November one thousand seven hundred and fortyone to answer unto his said Lordship in form aforesaid.

And now to witt at a Court held for the County aforesaid the third Tuesday of November being the Seventeenth Day of the same Month
