And the As^s Charles Benniwell in his own proper person Cometh and defendeth the fores and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action As^s of the As^s John Henry nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the As^s John Henry above against him Complaind and as to the damages of the same John by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Charles saith and acknowledgeth that the As^s John hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part appoyed to Two pounds fifteen Shillings and Eight pence Curr^t money of maryland and not more and because the As^s John deny not this but the same allegation grants to be true pray Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges As^s to him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by consent of the parties As^s It is considered that the As^s John Henry Recover against the As^s Charles Benniwell his damages As^s to the As^s Two pounds fifteen Shillings and Eight pence Curr^t money of maryland by the same Charles in form As^s acknowledge as also ²⁶⁵ Costs of tobacco for his costs and charges As^s to the same John at his Request by the Court now here of the assent of the parties As^s adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to Two pounds fifteen Shillings and Eight pence Curr^t money of maryland and ²⁶⁵ Costs of tobacco and the As^s Charles in Mercy &c.

vs. The Rev. Thomas Chase

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Thomas Chase late of Somerset County Clerk otherwise called Thomas Chase of Somerset County in Maryland Clerk if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to Answer unto Onorio Rosalina of a plea that he renders unto him the sum of fifty pounds sterling which to him he owes and unjustly detains &c. and the same day is given to the As^s Onorio here &c.

And the said Onorio Rosalina declared against the said Thomas Chase in the plea as in form following - Somerset vs Thomas Chase late of Somerset County Clerk otherwise called Thomas Chase of Somerset County in Maryland Clerk was summoned to Answer unto Onorio Rosalina of a plea that he renders unto him the sum of fifty pounds Sterling which to him he owes and unjustly
