Genl<sup>r</sup>: hath hanuid unto this Court the account of the Estate Atney Boston dec'd: wherein it is  
found that there is Balance due to the abovesaid Representat<sup>s</sup> the sum of three hundred and  
Nineteen pounds Eighteen Shillings and three pence half penny therefore if the abovesaid
