And the same day is given to the a^s. Thomas here &c.

At which day here came the a^s. Thomas Newbold by George Douglas his Attorney and the sheriffe to wit John Handy Gent. now here returned that he had taken the a^s. Daniel Young whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the a^s. Thomas Newbold of the a^s. plea as to him it was Commanded

Whereupon the a^s. Daniel Young puts in his place William Arbutche Gent. Attorney at Law against the a^s. Thomas Newbold of the a^s. plea

And thereupon at the request of the parties a^s. day is to them now here given untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County a^s. the third Tuesday of March then next following in the same state as at present saving to the parties a^s &c.

At which day here came again as well the a^s. Thomas Newbold as the a^s. Daniel Young by their Attorneys a^s and hereupon the said Thomas Newbold complained against the a^s. Daniel Young in the plea a^s. in form following. Somerset s^r. Daniel Young late of Somerset County planter was Attached to answer unto Thomas Newbold of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c.

And Whereupon the said Thomas by George Douglas his Attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas on the Eighth day of September Anno Dom MDCCL at the County a^s. was possessed of a Deer of the price of forty shillings Curr^t money of Maryland as of his proper deer and so being thereof possessed afterwards to wit the day and year a^s at the County a^s. the said deer out of his hands and possession Casually lost which said Deer afterwards
