

November Court 1741 200.

If it should happen that Judgement in the plea *Ass.* should be rendered for the same Robert Geddes against the said Richard Knight or that he the said Richard Knight should be therein convicted that then he the said Richard should pay and Satisfie unto the said Robert Geddes the Judgement of the Court thereupon or Render his body in Execution of such Judgement to the prison of the sheriffe of the County *Ass.* in Satisfaction thereof or that he the said Ambrose Rigger will do the same for him &c.

Whereupon the *Ass.* Richard Knight puts in his place George Douglass Gent. attorney at Law against the *Ass.* Robert Geddes of this *Ass.* plea &c.

And thereupon at the Request of the parties *Ass.* day is to them now here given & untill next Court to be held at deciding Creeks in and for the County *Ass.* the third Tuesday of June & then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the *Ass.* Robert here also &c.

At which day here came againe as well the *Ass.* Robert Geddes as the *Ass.* Richard Knight by their attorney *Ass.* and hereupon the said Robert Geddes complained of the *Ass.* Richard Knight in the plea *Ass.* in form following. . Somersel *ss.* Richard Knight later of Somersel County Planter was attached to answer unto Robert Geddes of a plea of trespass upon the Law &c.

And Whereupon the same Robert Geddes by Robert Jenakins. Henry his attorney complains that whereas the *Ass.* Richard after the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and five (to witt) the fourth day of August in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and forty at Somersel County did make his certain note in a writing called a promissary note with his proper hand thereunto subscribed bearing date the same day and a Year last mentioned which said note the same Richard to the said Robert Geddes then and there did deliver by which said note the *Ass.* Richard did promise to pay unto the same Robert Geddes or his order at the fall then next following the sum of Two pounds four shillings and nine pence in form or money for value Received by vertue of which Premises as also by force of the statute in such Case lately made and provided the same Richard became chargeable to pay unto the said Robert Geddes the sum of money *Ass.* according to the tenor of that note and so thereof chargeable being the *Ass.* Richard & afterwards to witt the same day and year last mentioned at Somersel County *Ass.* in consideration thereof

& upon
