At which day here come again as well the aforesaid Ambrose Willet and Ruth his wife as the aforesaid Peter and Shadrach Claywell by their Attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Peter and Shadrach Claywell as before defend the force and Injury when & And say that they are not nor either of them is guilty of the premises above upon them imposed as the aforesaid Ambrose Willet and Ruth his wife above against them have complained and of this they put themselves upon the Country and the aforesaid Ambrose and Ruth in like manner. Therefore it is Comanded the sheriffe that Immediately he should cause to come here before his Lordships Justices Twelve & by whom & and whom they to recognize & because as well & and the Jurors of that Jury being Called some of them to witt John Dennis J<sup>r</sup> John Woolford Ephraim Waggaman George Tull William Nelson James Polk Moses Mills & William Gray came and were Sworn upon that Jury and because the residue of the Jurors of that same Jury did not appear therefore others of those standing by hereunto affected by the sheriffe of the County aforesaid and at the request of the aforesaid Ambrose Willet & Ruth his wife and by the Command of the aforesaid Justices are newly put on whose names to the pannel within written are affixed according to the form of the statute in such case made and provided which said Jurors newly put on to witt David Polk Absolom Hobbs Samuel Powell Benjamin Langford being Called Likewise came who to say the truth of the premises aforesaid together with the other Jurors aforesaid first Impanned and Sworn being Elected tryed and Sworn and of their Verdict thereupon by the Court were charged and between themselves to Commune from the barr here did Recede and afterwards the same Jurors thereof between themselves agreed to their Verdict & upon the premises aforesaid to render to the barr here returned upon which the aforesaid Ambrose Willet and Ruth his wife altho' Solemnly Called Cometh not nor is their writ aforesaid against the said Peter & Shadrach Claywell further prosecuted

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Ambrose Willet and Ruth his wife and their pledges of prosecuting to witt John Doe and Richard Roe are in mercy and that the aforesaid Peter and Shadrach Claywell goe thereof without day & Also it is Considered that the aforesaid Peter and Shadrach Claywell recover against the aforesaid Ambrose Willet and Ruth his wife
