March 12th 1740 Came William Brereton and maid Oath on the Holy Evangelist of almighty God that the within Account is Just and true and that he hath not received anything In satisfaction or Security for the same before Tho: Gillis And the aforesaid Absolum Hobbs being present here in Court in his proper person at the prayer of the aforesaid William Brereton is adjudged to give Speciall bail to the Action aforesaid — Thereupon Came hereinto Court a certain Christopher Doodle of Somerset County planter in his proper person and undertook for the said Absolum Hobbs Likewise the said Absolum Hobbs present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for the same William Brereton against the said Absolum Hobbs or that he the said Absolum Hobbs should be therein Convict that then he the said Absolum should pay and Satisfie unto the said William Brereton the Judgment of the Court thereupon or tender his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff.
