And hereupon the said Thomas Sanders complained of the as^t Wilson M^r Norman in the plea as^t in form following - Somerset s^r Wilson M^r Norman late of Somerset County planter was Attached to Answer unto Thomas Sanders of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c

And Whereupon the same Thomas by Robert Jenckins Henry his Attorney complains that whereas the as^t Wilson after the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and five - (to wit^t the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred forty and one at Somerset County - as^t did make his certain note in writing called a promissory note with his proper hand subscribed bearing date the same day and year last above mentioned and that Note to the same Thomas then and there did deliver by which said note the said Wilson did promise to pay to the said Thomas or his Heirs the full and just sum of two pounds - fourteen shillings and nine pence upon demand for value received and by reason thereof as also by Virtue of the statute in such case lately made and provided the same Wilson became Chargeable to pay unto the said Thomas the sum of money as^t According to the tenor of the said Note and so thereof Chargeable being the as^t Wilson in consideration thereof afterwards (to wit^t the as^t first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fortyone at Somerset County as^t upon himself did assume and to the same Thomas then and there faithfully promise to pay to him the as^t Sum of money agreeable to the tenor of that Note Nevertheless the as^t Wilson his promise and assumption as^t in form as^t made little regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the -
