

were adjudged for his damages which he had by Occasion of a certain promise and Assumption by the same John to the aforesaid Lawrence made and not performed whereof he is convicted &c. And the same day is given to the aforesaid Lawrence here

All which day here came the aforesaid Lawrence Evans by Francis Allen his Attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Henry Gent now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid John Collins whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the aforesaid Lawrence of the damages aforesaid as to him it was commanded &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Sheriff altho' at the same day solemnly called bring not in the body of the aforesaid John Collins according to the Return of the writ aforesaid but made default &c.

For William Seal. Committed was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take George Ruppell. George Ruppell late of Somerset County Mariner otherwise called George Ruppell of Somerset County in the province of Maryland if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to satisfy William Seal as well a certain debt of sixty five pounds current money of Maryland which to the same William Seal in the same Court the Justice thereof at dividing Creek recovered against him as of the hundred and ninety seven pounds of tobacco which to the same William Seal in the same Court were adjudged for his damages which he had by Occasion of the detention of that same debt whereof he is convicted . . .

All which day here came the aforesaid William Seal by George Douglas his Attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Handy Gent: now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid George Ruppell whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the aforesaid William Seal of the debt and damages aforesaid as to him it was commanded. and the said George Ruppell being by the said Sheriff led to the Bar by virtue of the writ aforesaid and being by the Court here asked whether he was not the same George the same person that the aforesaid Wm. ^{Seal} in the damages aforesaid above ^{was} indicted or not saith that he is. Thereupon the same George Ruppell is committed to the prison of the aforesaid Sheriff there to remain in safe custody until the aforesaid William Seal of his damages aforesaid should be contented and satisfied &c.

Ordered that Adam Bufford recover against Rosannah Williams One hundred ^(Twenty) pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his attendance four days as an evidence on behalf of the said Rosannah. Williams
