Therefore command is to the sheriff of the County afo^r that by the Oath of Honest and Lawfull men of his baileywick he diligently Enquire what Damages the afo^r Duncan Murray hath sustained as well by Occasion of the non performance of the promise and Assumption afo^r as for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part expended and the Execution which thereupon he takes to his Lordships Justices at the next Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following under his seal and the seals of them by whose Oath he takes that same Enquiry he send together with the writs thereunto him directed and the same day is given to the afo^r Duncan Murray.

At which day here came the afo^r Edm^d Hough by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff to w^t John Handy Gent: now here returned that he had taken the afo^r Alexander Buncl Robert King and Ann his wife whose bodys heret^t this day he had ready to answer the afo^r Edm^d Hough of the afo^r plea as to him it was commanded.

Whereupon the afo^r Alexander Buncl and Robert King and Ann his wife puts in their place William Gibucake Gent: attorney at law against the afo^r Edm^d Hough of the afo^r plea &c

And hereupon then at the request of the parties aforesaid day is to them nowhere given until next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County afo^r the third Tuesday of August then next following in the same state and present serving to the parties afo^r &c

At which day here came again as well the afo^r Edm^d Hough as the afo^r Alexander Buncl and Robert King and Ann his wife by their attorney afo^r and hereupon the said Edm^d Hough complained of the afo^r Alexander Buncl and Robert King and Ann his wife in the plea afo^r in form following. . . .
