 a<sup>r</sup>o and hereupon the said John Morsey prays that the a<sup>r</sup>o Nathaniel Jackson to his declaration a<sup>r</sup>o may answer but  
 the said Nathaniel at the same day altho' solemnly called <sup>therof sayeth</sup> came not nor nothing in bar or preclusion of the action a<sup>r</sup>o of the  
 a<sup>r</sup>o John by which the same John Remained thereof against him undefended & for which reason the a<sup>r</sup>o John his  
 damages against the a<sup>r</sup>o Nathaniel ought to recover but because it is not known unto his Lordships Justices here what Damages  
 the a<sup>r</sup>o John hath sustained by occasion of the non performance of the promise and Assumption a<sup>r</sup>o in this part sustained

Therefore command is to the sheriff of the County a<sup>r</sup>o that by the Oath of honest and lawfull men of his baileys  
 he diligently inquire what Damages the a<sup>r</sup>o John Morsey has sustained as well by occasion of the non performance of the promise  
 a<sup>r</sup>o as for his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part expended and the Inquisition which thereupon he takes to his Lordships  
 Justices at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following under his seal and the seals  
 of them by whose Oath he takes that same Inquisition he send together with the writ thereto directed and the same  
 day is given to the a<sup>r</sup>o John here
