And Whereupon the said Nathaniel Jackson by Francis Allen his attorney comes and defendeth the force and injury which he doth pray leave thereof to Imparle here untill next Court to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County a^p the third Tuesday of November then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the a^p John here also

At which day here came again as well the a^p John Morsey as the a^p Nathaniel Jackson by their attorney a^p and hereupon the said John Morsey prays that the a^p Nathaniel Jackson to his declaration a^p may answer but the said Nathaniel at the same day altho' solemnly called ^{therof saith} came not nor nothing in barr or preclusion of the action a^p of the a^p John by which the same John Remaineth thereof against him undepended ^{for} for which reason the a^p John his damages against the a^p Nathaniel ought to recover but because it is not known unto his Lordships Justices here what Damages the a^p John hath sustained by Occasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption a^p in this part sustained

Therefore Command is to the sheriff of the County a^p that by the oath of honest and Lawfull men of his County he diligently Inquire what Damages the a^p John Morsey has sustained as well by Occasion of the non performance of ^{the promise} and assumption a^p as for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part expended and the Inquisition which thereupon he takes to his Lordships Justices at the next Court to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March then next following under his seal and the seals of them by whose Oath he takes that same Inquisition he send together with the writt thereof to him directed and the same day is given to the a^p John there
