And whereupon proclamation being made and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit

Thomas Gowan, Philip Spicer, Edward Maghamore, Aaron Tillman, James Narr, Joseph Porter, John  
Sturgis, William Friggs, William Revelle, John White, William Jarman, and Christopher Liper, and there-  
upon proclamation being made in common form the Jurors aforesaid so as aforesaid impanelled being  
severally called over by their names, appeared as above and were sworn and charged to inquire and  
sent out to consider soon after the grand Jurors aforesaid being impanelled sworn and charged  
as aforesaid return here into Court and severally called over appear and being asked if they had found  
any bills of indictment return the several bills following against William Lane son of Geo: violet  
Davis, Elizabeth Spear, Owen Sulavan, Benjamin Denison, Elizabeth Trehearn, and whereupon  
the Grand Jurors are discharged and ordered that they be allowed five hundred pounds of tobacco for  
their publick service this Court to be allowed of in the County Levy in November then next following  
and against the aforesaid W<sup>m</sup>: Lane, Elizabeth Spear, Owen Sulavan, Benjamin Denison and Eli-  
zabeth Trehearn so as aforesaid Indicted it is ordered that copies of the Billable against them to June Court  
then next following.

Upon the motion of Robert Jenkins Henry Gentle prosecutor of his Lordship's Pleas  
in Somerset County Court it is ordered that he direct and give orders for the issuing out of all  
such Subpoenas as he should think proper to testify against any person or persons what soever to  
the grand Jury this Court Day
