Whereupon the Court being called and sat as above proceeded to business in manner following -
 and thereupon proclamation being made and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Handy Gentleman makes Return of a pannell of grand Jurors as followeth to wit - Nicholas Fountain Thomas Whider, Alexander Marry, John Goddard, Isaac Williams, Whittington King, William Bozman, Thomas Givan, Philip Spier, Edward Maglamony, Aaron Tillman, James Navin, Joseph Porter, John Furgis, William Frigg, William Revelle, John White, William Jannan, and Christopher Liper, and thereupon proclamation being made in common form the Jurors aforesaid so as aforesaid Impannelled being severally called Over by their names, appeared as above and were sworn and charged to Inquire and sent Out to Consider & soon after the grand Jurors aforesaid being Impannelled sworn and charged as aforesaid Return here into Court and severally called Over appear and being asked if they had found any bills of Indictment Return the severall bills following against William Lane son of Geo: Violet Davis, Elizabeth Spear, Owen Pulawan, Benjamin Derison, Elizabeth Trehearn, and thereupon the Grand Jurors are discharged and Ordered that they be allowed five hundred pounds of tobacco for their publick Service this Court to be allowed of in the County Levy in November then next following and against the afo^r W^m: Lane, Elizabeth Spear, Owen Pulawan, Benjamin Derison and Elizabeth Trehearn so as aforesaid Indicted it is Ordered that fascias Issue Returnable against them to June Court then next following.

UPON the motion of Robert Jenckins Henry Gents prosecutor of his Lordships pleas in Somerset County Court It is Ordered that he direct and give Orders for the Issuing Out of all such Subponas as he should think proper to testify against any person or persons what soever to the grand Jury this Court &c
