Sam'l Jones appointed Overseer of the Roads in stead of John Williams from Rose Throowfair to Joseph Gold and from Joseph Golds to the head of Little Creek, and from Richard Wallis's into the main Road 800 --

That whereas your petitioner having a negro woman called Philli which through age and other infirmities is rendered almost or altogether useles to your petitioner or any of his Your petitioner humbly pray your worships will be pleased to take it into consideration and set her free -- and your petitioner as his duty bound shall ever pray.

The petition aforesaid being Read and heard and fully understood It is considered that the aforesaid negro woman Philli be for the future free as by the petition aforesaid is prayed.

The humble petition of Patrick Mc Kenney of Somerset County humbly sheweth that your petitioner having Land Lying in Annamoe on the head of Jones's Creek called heart Con: tent humbly pray your worships will be pleased to grant your petitioner a Commission to prove the boundaries thereof which otherwise may prove of bad consequence to your petitioner if not timely performed and your petitioner shall ever pray --

The petition aforesaid being Read and heard and fully understood It is considered by the Court here that a Commission I give to the aforesaid Patrick Mc Kenney as by the petition aforesaid is prayed and that Thomas Williams, Nicholas Fossum, John Waters and Charles Roach of Somerset County Gentlemen be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided for.

William Duet appointed Overseer of the Roads in Annamoe hundred for the ensuing year in stead of Charles Roach.
