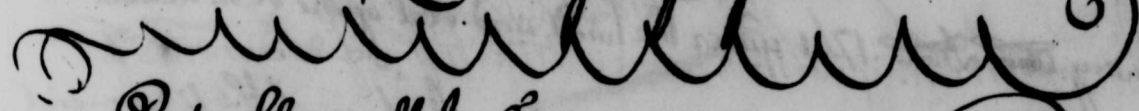


Security in manner following: Thereupon the said Patrick Connelly, together with James Anderson of Somerset County planter, Janet Wiley of the same place planter, and William Brown of the same place planter, his security, all present herein Court, in their proper persons, acknowledged themselves to owe unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland, in manner and form following vizt the aforesaid Patrick Connelly in Two hundred pounds Current money of the Province aforesaid, and the aforesaid James Anderson, Janet Wiley, and William Brown in Sixty six pounds, thirteen Shillings and four pence each, the money of their bodies, goods or Chattels, Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors --

If it happen that the said Patrick Connelly do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's Provincial Court, to be held at the City of Annapolis the second Tuesday of April the next following and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and concerning all such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him, or his said Lordship's behalf, and do not stand and abide the judgment of the Court thereon and do depart the same Court without leave, and in the meantime if he keeps not the peace, and be not of the good behaviour to all his said Lordship's good people &c

Whereupon the same Peter Claywell with Hutton Hill and Jonathan Stungis of Somerset County planters his securitys present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland in the full and Just sum of five pounds Current money of said Province of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors. If it happen that the said Peter Claywell do not pay and Relieve unto the Sheriff of the County aforesaid for the time being fifty Shillings Current money of the province aforesaid yearly and Every year he shall keep such Ordinary or house of Entertainment as aforesaid. Likewise the said Peter Claywell with the aforesaid Hutton Hill and Jonathan Stungis his securitys aforesaid all present herein Court in their proper persons as aforesaid acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in forty pounds of Maryland of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or tenements severally to be made and Levied to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors if it happen that the said
