Somerset County / By virtue of a commission to us directed bearing date the 26 of November 1740 to examine
Evidences in relation to the boundaries of two tracts of Land lying in the County aforesaid the one called Grouse
the other Castle quarter on behalf of a Captain Hugh Stevenson of the County aforesaid
We the subscribers being qualified have appointed a day as the said dates and have
mett on the aforesaid land and there layed to come before us this 10th of March 1741/2

Ephraim Heather aged Seventy three years or there abouts being sworn on the holy
Evangelist of almighty God do say that the aforesaid white Oak standing on the south side
of a branch commonly known and called George Frewitts branch and up the said branch and
above Mr: Stevensons plantation about a quarter of a mile it being the first boundary of
of Grouse and the said Heather was shewed a live oak by Mr: Davis standing in a branch
a little above the main Road that leads from Snowhill upwads a top the said branch
and the said Heather carried us to a little Old field called Hooks Field and showed a stump
where now is fixt a sassafras Post notched with four notches on each side that is to say
sixteen notches and that he was shewed the tree were now the Sassafras post stands by
John Miller at the Request of Mr: Davis forty years agoe and further saith not

George Frewitt aged fifty years or there abouts being sworn on the holy Evangelist of
almighty God do say that the above mentioned aforesaid white oak standing as before mentioned
is the first boundary of the land called Grouse and further saith not
