Catherine Steward adm^r of the Reverend Mr. William Steward late of Somerset County dec^d. being summoned to appear at this Court to give security according to act of assembly for the Balance of the said dec^d's Estate &c

And now to wit this nineteenth day of August One thousand seven hundred and forty came hereunto Court the said Catherine Steward in her proper person and made it appear to the satisfaction of the Court here, that the County Court of Somerset had formerly, upon the petition of a certain Robert Hodge, ordered the Estate out of her hands (and to be delivered to the said Hodge he being her security on the administration of the Estate afo^r) agreeable to act of assembly in such case provided Whereupon the said Catherine Steward is discharged by the Court here from the Subp^{ena} afo^r &c

Mary Anderson came hereunto Court in her proper person according to Subp^{ena} for her appearance here to give security for the Balance of the Estate of a certain Thomas Gray dec^d. And forasmuch as the said Mary made it appear here to the satisfaction of the Court that she had paid away justly all the Estate of the said Gray and that nothing thereof did remain &c
Whereupon the said Mary is discharged by the Court here from the Subp^{ena} aforesaid &c

John Roach of Somerset County came hereunto Court in his proper person, according to a certain Subp^{ena} for his appearance here to give security for the Balance of the Estate of a certain Samuel Roach dec^d —

And forasmuch as the said John Roach made it appear to the satisfaction of the Court here, that he had justly paid away that part of the Estate, of the said Samuel Roach, as by the will of the said Samuel ought to be paid, and that the residue of the said Estate was given to him by the said Samuel as by will appears &c

Whereupon the said John Roach is discharged by the Court here from the Subp^{ena} aforesaid &c

Ordered that Mr. Robert King agree with some doctor or other person to take care of John Tindall son of James Tindall to administer medicines and Endeavour to perfect a cure on him, he being afflicted with a very sore Leg &c

And Likewise provide all such other necessaries as he the said Robert King shall think proper and that allowance be made at the next Levy Court for the same &c

Ordered that Arabella Mitchell be allowed five pounds Curr^t. money of Maryland she bringing in the first best piece of Linnen according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c

Ordered that M^r. Catherine Rownd be allowed four pounds Curr^t. money of Maryland she bringing in the second best piece of Linnen according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c

Ordered that M^r. Southy Whittington be allowed three pounds Curr^t. Money of Maryland he bringing in the third and last piece of Linnen according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c

Ordered that Robert King of the County aforesaid Esq^r. procure a special Warrent, and all other things that necessary for the surveying of the Land called Little derry, whereon the Court house for the County afo^r is desired to stand
