

This Lordship - - Somerset /
Dominick Dennis

Memorandum that at a Court of the his Lordship the ~
right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland held at Dividing
 Creek the third Tuesday of November to wit the seventeenth day of the same month Anno Domini one
 thousand seven hundred and forty one before his said Lordships Justices the peace in the County aforesaid
 to keep & signed by the oath of twelve Jurors presented that Dominick Dennis late of All Hallows parish
 in the said County of Somerset planter the sixteenth day September in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and forty one with force and arms at the parish aforesaid within the County aforesaid within the
 Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain Samuel Davis in the peace of God and the same Lord
 Proprietary then and there being an assault did make and him the said Samuel Davis then and there
 did beat wound and evill treat so that of his life it was greatly dispaireed and other harmes to him then
 and there did to the grieuous damage of him the said Samuel and contrary to the peace of the said Lord
 Proprietary that now is his good rule and government.

Thereupon command was given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said
 Dominick Dennis if he should be found in his baileyniche and him should safe keep so that he might have his body
 before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of
 March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to answer unto his said Lordship of the Indictment
 aforesaid.

And now to wit the third Tuesday of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred
 and forty one at about the said time before his Lordships Justices came the aforesaid
 Dominick Dennis in his proper person and had hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and saith that he will not
 plead with his said Lordship but submits with a protestation of his Innocency and puts himself upon
 the favour of the Court.

Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood It is
 directed by the Court here that the aforesaid Dominick Dennis pay unto his Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary
 of the province of Maryland for his fine by the Court here upon him imposed for and by occasion of the premises
 aforesaid whereof it is for in aforesaid he is convicted five shillings current money of Maryland and that the said Dominick Dennis be
 be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid.

Whereupon the said Dominick Dennis is ordered to give security for the payment of all fees or fees
 due on the Indictment aforesaid to any person or persons what soever ~ Thereupon Joshua Sturges and William
 Jarman both of Somerset County planters present herein Court in their proper persons undertake for the said Dominick
 Dennis
