fine aforesaid Thereupon the said Violet Davis is ordered to give security for the payment of all fee or  
fees due on the Indictment aforesaid to any person or persons what severall thereupon a certain Robert Davis son  
of William Davis of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said  
Violet Davis to pay any fee or fees and all fees that might accrue during the course of the premises and Indictment  
aforesaid to any person or persons whatsoever &c
