Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood is considered by the Court here that the afo^r Armdah pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor for her fine by the Court here upon her Imprisoned for and by Occasion of his premises afo^r whereof in form afo^r she is Condict Thirti shillings Curr^t money of Maryland and that the afo^r Armdah Wheeler be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine afo^r.

Whereupon the said Armdah Wheeler is ordered to give security for the payment of all fees or fees due on the information afo^r to any person or persons whatsoever. Thereupon a certain Samuel Hopkins of Somerset County Gent^r present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Armdah Wheeler to pay all fees or fees that might accrue due by mean of the said information afo^r to any person or persons whatsoever.

Be it Remembred that Robert Jenckins Henry Gent^r Attorney of the right honourable the Lord Proprietor that now is who for the same Lord Proprietor in this part prosecuteth, doth come here into the County Court of the same Lord Proprietor held for Somerset County afo^r to wit at dividing Creek in the same County the Sixteenth Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty one before John Scott Esq^r and his Associates the said Lord Proprietor his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord Proprietor doth give the Court here to understand and be informed that Solomon Cooper late of Alphallorus parish in the said County of Somerset planter the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty one at the parish afo^r in the County afo^r within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain Armdah Wheeler and of her body then and there had carnal knowledge and a bastard child on the body of her the same Armdah Wheeler then and there did beget to the high displeasure of almighty God to the evill example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the same Lord Proprietor that now is his good rule and government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided whereupon the said Attorney of the same Lord Proprietor for the same Lord Proprietor prays advice of the Court herein the premises and due process of Law in this part against the same Solomon Cooper may be made to answer unto the said Lord Proprietor of and upon the premises.

Whereupon command is to the Sheriff of the County afo^r that he should take the said Solomon Cooper if he doth not appear within afo^r time to answer to him now to wit at that same Court held for the County afo^r at dividing Creek this Sixteenth Day of March anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one before the afo^r Justices comes the afo^r Solomon Cooper according to a certain recognizance by him and his Security in this part first acknowledged and had a hearing of the Information afo^r and saith that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of the premises afo^r in the Information
