and do depart the same Court without Leave thereto and afterwards the aforesaid Recognition by the Court here discharged

Samuel Parker before his Lordships Justices at a Court then held at dividing Creek a Certam Samuel Parker pres-
ent here in Court in his proper person is Ordered to give Recognition in ten pounds Current
money for his appearance at June Court then next following to give Evidence on behalf of his Lordship against Dennock
Dennis for an affault &c

Whereupon the said Samuel Parker present here in Court as aforesaid acknowledged him-
self Indebted unto his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary in ten pounds Current money of Maryland of his body good,
or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Levied If it happen
that the said Samuel Parker do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of
Sommersel to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June then next following and do not then and there give such
Evidence as he shall know on behalf of his Lordship against the aforesaid Dennock Dennis for an affault and do depart the
same Court without Leave thereto and afterwards the aforesaid Recognition is by the Court here discharged

His Lordship - Whereas a Certam John Lamberson and Alexander Maddox of Sommersel County planters
John Lamberson being guilty of an affault in the publick view of the Court, the Justices in Court Judicially Siting
and Alexander Maddox - Whereupon the Sheriff of Sommersel County is Ordered to take the said John Lamberson
and the said Alexander Maddox into his custody and them safe keep so that he might have their
bodies here immediately in Court to answer the premises aforesaid &c And afterwards in the same Court came
the said John Lamberson and Alexander Maddox in custody of the Sheriff of his County aforesaid into whose custody
before that time for the cause aforesaid were committed and being by the Sheriff aforesaid set to the Barre is thereupon
instantly demanded howthey would thereof acquit themselves of the premises aforesaid, sayell that they and each of
them are guilty of the premises aforesaid and putt them upon the general of the Court &c

Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the aforesaid John Lamberson pay unto his Lordship aforesaid
