unjustly detains &c — And Whereupon the same Stephen by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney  
saith that Whereas the said William the fifth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven  
hundred forty one at Sommerset County aforesaid by his certain Bill penall sealed with the seal of the said  
William and which the said Stephen here exhibits hereto Court, the date whereof is the same day and year —  
acknowledged himself to owe and be justly indebted to the same Stephen by the name of Stephen  
Banks planter the sum of four pounds Two Shillings and nine pence Current money of Maryland
