Ms Francis Allen .. His Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the
Edmund Hough bail of the Province of Maryland commanded his Sheriff of Somerset County by his
Wm Whittington .. writ in these words following vid. Command to Charles absolute Lord and
proprietor of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore.

To the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting whereas a certain Edmund Hough of Somerset County Gentleman in our
County Court of Somerset hereto with the twentieth day of June anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty
before Robert King Esq: and his associates then our Justices of our said Court at dividing Creek in our said County
undertook for a certain William Whittington late of Somerset County Gent: and affirmed upon himself that if it should
happen that a certain Francis Allen should recover Judgment in the said Court against the said William Whittington
in a certain plea of trespass upon the case by the same Francis Allen against the afo' William Whittington in our
same Court prosecuted or that the same William should be therein convicted that then the said William all the damages
which to the same Francis in our same Court herein the afo' plea of trespass upon the case shant should be adjudged
he would satisfy or render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County of
Essex in satisfaction thereof that he the said Edmund Hough would do the same for him and altho' the said Francis
affirmed at a Court held in and for the County afo' at dividing Creek the second tenth day of March and year afo'
last mentioned before the afo' Robert King Esq: and his associates our Justices of our County Court afo' at
dividing Creek afo' by consideration of the same Court recovered against the afo' William Whittington security pound
fourteen shillings curr: money of Maryland and two hundred and thirty six pounds of tobacco for his damages
which the said Francis sustained by occasion of the non performance of a certain promise and assumption by the afo'
William Whittington to the afo' Francis made and not performed whereof he is convicted by the record and proceedings
thereof now remaining in our same Court before our said Justices of dividing Creek afo' manifestly appeareth Nevertheless
the said William hath not satisfied the said Francis of his damages afo' nor rendered his body in Execution of the
Judgment afo' to the prison of the Sheriff afo' as by information from the same Francis we have received and because
we are willing that those things which in our said Court before our Justices are rightly done should be duly Executed
thereof we command you by good and lawfull men of your bailey which you make known unto the afo' Edmund
Hough that he be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third
Tuesday of March then next following to shew cause if any thing for himself he hath or to say knoweth wherfore the
afo' Francis Allen his Execution against him of the damages afo' to have ought not according to the form of the
recognition afo' if to him it shall seem most expedient and have you then and there the names of them by whom
to him you make known and this will witness John Scott Gent: one of our Justices of our said Court the twenty
sixth day of November anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one — att
