And the aforesaid Daniel Harrick at the same day altho' solemnly called came not nor shews cause why &c. but made default &c.

Whereupon the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins prays that upon giving Security according to act of assembly in such case made and provided the aforesaid sum of Sixteen pounds Six Shillings and Eleven pence Current money of Maryland so as aforesaid acknowledged by the aforesaid John Records Garnishee as aforesaid and the severall goods and Chattles so as aforesaid attached on the proper goods and Chattles of his aforesaid Daniel Harrick
