Thereupon a certain Robert Jenkins Henry of Somerset County Gentleman present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Samuel Hopkins according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided that in Case Daniel Harriet do at anytime within a year and a day appear and make all or any part of the said Samuel Hopkins Claim against him to appear to be satisfied or otherwise to have been undue before the Laying of this Attachment that then the said Samuel Hopkins shall make restitution unto the said Daniel Harriet of all or such part as shall be so made appears to be undue as aforesaid or that he the said Robert Jenkins Henry will do the same for him

Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Sum of Fifteen pound Six Shillings and Eleven pence Curr: so as aforesaid acknowledged (as part of the Sum so as aforesaid attached) by the aforesaid John Records be condemned in his hands as of the Rights and Credits of the aforesaid Daniel Harriet towards Satisfying unto the said Samuel Hopkins his debt aforesaid and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid and that the aforesaid Samuel Hopkins have thereof Execution against the said John Records according to act of Assembly in such Case provided or

also it is considered by the Court here that the several goods and Chattels so as aforesaid attached of the value of thirty three pounds Twelve Shillings and three pence Curr: money of Maryland be condemned as the goods and Chattels of the aforesaid Daniel Harriet towards Satisfying unto the said Samuel Hopkins his debt aforesaid and all Costs and Charges accruing by means of the attachment aforesaid and that the said Samuel Hopkins have hereof Execution

for John Nicholson } John Nicholson late of Somerset County planter otherwise called John Nicholson of Somerset County in the province of Maryland planter if he should be found in his body with and him should safe Keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Court the third Tuesday of March next. One thousand Seven hundred and forty One to answer unto John Henry of a plea that he Render unto him Ten pounds Two Shillings Curr: money of Maryland which to him he Owes and unjustly detains &c. and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Henry here  
At which day here came the aforesaid John Henry by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Hand Gentleman now here returned that he had Taken the aforesaid John Nicholson whose body here at this day he had ready to present unto the aforesaid John Henry of the aforesaid plea as to him it was Commanded
