Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he
for Samuel McClester shd take Samuel McClester late of Somerset County planter otherwise
called Samuel Maclester of Somerset County if he shd be found in his bailiwick
and him shd safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County
Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March anno Domini thousand seven
hundred and forty one to answer unto Charles Carroll of a plea that he render unto him the sum of twenty
Eight pounds fifteen shillings curr^t money which to him he owes and unjustly detains & on the same day
is given to the aforesaid Charles here ges

And hereupon the said Charles Carroll declared of the aforesaid Samuel Maclester in the plea aforesaid in forme
following - Somerset s^rt Samuel McClester late of Somerset County planter otherwise called Samuel
Maclester of Somerset County was summoned to answer unto Charles Carroll of a plea that he render unto
him the sum of twenty Eight pounds fifteen shillings curr^t money which to him he owes and unjustly
detains ges And Whereupon the same Charles by Robert Jenckins Henry his Attorney says that

Whereas the aforesaid Samuel the twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and forty at Somerset County by his certain Writing obligatorily did grant himself to be held and firmly
bound to the said Charles in the aforesaid sum of twenty Eight pounds fifteen shillings curr^t money to be paid
to the aforesaid Charles when thereof he should be requested Nevertheless the said Samuel altho often requested
the aforesaid Twenty Eight pounds and fifteen shillings unto the same Charles he hath not rendered but the same
to him he has to render hath refused and still doth refuse Whereupon he says he is the worse and hath
Damage to the value of twenty pounds curr^t money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit & doth bring
herrinto Court the writing aforesaid which the debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth testify the date of which is the same day
and year aforesaid

And the aforesaid Samuel McClester in his proper person comes and defends the aforesaid Injury where
aforesaid saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Charles Carroll nor can he say but that
the writing obligatorily aforesaid is his deed nor but that he owes the same Charles Carroll the aforesaid Twenty Eight
pounds
