 Patrick altho often required the aforesaid Eighteen pounds Eight shillings unto the same Denton he hath not rendered but
 the same to him hitherto to render hath refused and still doth refuse Whereupon he say he is worse and hath damage to the
 value of Thirtie pounds curr. money of and thereof he brings suit to and brings hereinto Court the writing aforesaid which
 the debt aforesaid doth testify the date of which is the same day and year aforesaid — { P. D. J. D. & P. }

 in the aforesaid sum of One hundred pounds currant money aforesaid to be paid to the said Thomas when there of he
