D Pat. Connelly. Connelly of Somerset County was Summoned to answer unto Denton Carroll of a plea that he  
render unto him Eighteen pounds Eight shillings <sup>current money of Maryland</sup> which to him he owes and Unjustly detains &c

And Whereupon the same Denton by Robert Jenckins Henry his Attorney says that whereas the aforesaid  
Patrick the XX day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty at Somerset County by  
his Certain Writing obligatory did grant himself to be held and firmly bound to the said Denton in the aforesaid Eighteen  
pounds Eight shillings money aforesaid to be paid to the said Denton when thereof he should be requested Nevertheless the said  
Patrick altho' often required the aforesaid Eighteen pounds Eight shillings unto the same Denton he hath not rendered but  
the same to him hitherto to render hath refused and still doth refuse Whereupon he says he is worse and hath damage to the  
Value of thirty pounds Curr<sup>t</sup> money aforesaid and thereof he brings suit &c And brings herinto Court the writing aforesaid which  
the debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth testify the date of which is the same day and year aforesaid *Meoq. 83. Doe. 2. 1741*

And the aforesaid Patrick Connelly by Geo. Douglas his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury  
when &c and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid Denton Carroll nor can he say but that the writing  
obligatory aforesaid is the deed of the same Patrick nor but that he owes the same Denton the aforesaid Eighteen pounds Eight  
shillings Curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland in manner and form as the aforesaid Denton above against him hath declared &c

Therefore it is Considered that the aforesaid Denton Carroll recover against the aforesaid Patrick

at Somerset County by his Certain Writing Obligatory did grant himself to be held and firmly bound to the said Thomas  
in the aforesaid Sum of One hundred pounds Currant money aforesaid to be paid to the said Thomas when thereof he  
should be requested Nevertheless the said Stephen altho' often requested the aforesaid One hundred pounds unto  
the said Thomas he hath not rendered but the same to him hitherto to render hath refused and still doth refuse where  
upon he says he is the worse and hath damage to the Value of One hundred pounds Curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland and  
thereof he brings his Suit &c. and brings herinto Court the writing aforesaid which the debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth
