At which day here came the <sup>of Somerset County</sup> <sup>as</sup> <sup>of</sup> Patrick Connelly by George Douglas his Attorney and the sheriff to wit — John Handys gent now here returned that he had taken the <sup>as</sup> Hugh Rimmer whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly of the <sup>as</sup> plea to him it was commanded —

Whereupon the <sup>as</sup> Hugh Rimmer being present herein Court at the prayer of the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly is adjuged to give speciall bail to the action of —

Thereupon a certain James Billings of Somerset County gent present herein Court in his proper person understood for the said Hugh Rimmer likewise the said Hugh Rimmer present herein Court in his proper person assented upon hi self that if it should happen that judgment in the plea of — should be made for the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly — against the same Hugh Rimmer or that he the same Hugh Rimmer should be therein Convict that then he the said Hugh Rimmer should pay and satisfe unto the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly the Judgment of the Court thereupon or render his body in execution of such Judgment to the prison of the sheriff of the County of — in satisfaction therof that he the said James Billings will do the same for him &c —

Whereupon the <sup>as</sup> Hugh Rimmer puts in his place Robert Jenkins Henry gent Attorney at Law against the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly of the <sup>as</sup> plea

And thereupon at the request of the parties a day is to them now here given untill next Court to be held — at dividing Cmsh in aid for the County of — the third Tuesday of August next following at the same state as at present savinge to the parties of —

At which day here came again as well the <sup>as</sup> Patrick Connelly as the <sup>as</sup> Hugh Rimmer by their attorney <sup>as</sup> and hereupon the said Patrick complained against the <sup>as</sup> Hugh Rimmer in the plea of — in form following — Somerset / Hugh Rimmer late of Somerset County planter was attached to answer unto Patrick Connelly of a plea of — trespass upon the case of —

And Whereupon the said Patrick by Geo: Douglas his Attorney complains that whereas the said Patrick is a good and honest subject of our Lord the King that now is and as such from his nativity to this day himself hath governed and from all felonies stealing theft or receiving of stolen goods knowing the same to be stolen free clear and unspotted by all the time <sup>as</sup> he hath remained Nevertheles <sup>s</sup> the said Hugh not ignorant of the premises but plotting and maliciously intending the said Patrick in his good name <sup>as</sup> to hurt and injure and the said Patrick injuriously to vex and into the manifest danger of his life imprisonment of his body loss of his goods or personal punishment or fine to the <sup>as</sup> proprietor of this province to make manifestly to endanger and curse without any probable or reasonable cause on the xxix day of March June anno Domini Dcxl at Somerset County before the worshipfull Robert King Esq: and his associates the Right Honourable the said <sup>as</sup> proprietor <sup>as</sup> Justices to keep the peace for the said County aforesaid procures and causeth information in writing to be drawn up and written against the said Patrick Connelly —
