of Godfrey Sprogle credits which were of Godfrey Sprogle lately deceased at the time of his death with the testament of
The said Godfrey annexed if he should be found in his Bailewick and him should safe keep so that he might have his
body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the
Third Tuesday of June Anno Dom^m one thousand seven hundred and forty — to answer unto Dunken Murray of a plan
of trespass upon the said — And the same day is given to the aforesaid Dunken Murray

At which day here came the aforesaid Dunken Murray by Robert Jenkins Henry his Attorney and the Sheriff
to witness John Henry Gent now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Edmond Crapper whose body here at this day he
had ready to answer the aforesaid Dunken Murray of the aforesaid plea unto him it was commanded

And hereupon the said Edmond Crapper puts in his place William Arbuckle Gent Attorney at law against the aforesaid
Dunken Murray of the aforesaid plea —

Whereupon at the request of the parties aforesaid day is to them now here given untill next Court to be held at Dividing Creek
the Third Tuesday of August then next following in the same state as at present saveing to the parties aforesaid —

At which day here came againe as well the aforesaid Dunken Murray as the aforesaid Edmond Crapper and by their attor
neys aforesaid and whereupon the aforesaid Dunken who offered the writt aforesaid against the aforesaid Edmond Crapper and of
the aforesaid plea did not prosecute the same writt — Therefore he and his pledges of prosecuting are in mercy
and let the plaintiff name pledges &c and that the aforesaid Edmond Crapper and Administrator of the aforesaid Godfrey Sprogle goe
hence without day — Also it is considered that the aforesaid Edmond Crapper recover against the aforesaid

Dunken Murray his damages by reason of the premises to One hundred and Seventy One pounds of
149.
