Affumption ag^t whilst the said Wheately was a single man and unmarried was ready and often offered himself to the said Wheately for her husband lawfully to Marry and take to wife at Somerset County ag^t Nevertheless the said Wheately whilst he was a single man and unmarried his promise and affumption ag^t little regarding but plotting and fraudulently intending her the said Sarah did that part first of the contract of marriage and so induced her the said Sarah did not marry and take to wife altho' she same to do the said Wheately after the promise and affumption ag^t made to will on the seventeenth day of November in the year ag^t and often as well before as after at Somerset County ag^t by the said Sarah he was thereunto requested but her the said Sarah to marry and take to wife did altogether refuse and afterwards to will on the twenty-fourth day of November ag^t in the year ag^t at a certain place called Accomack County in Virginia to will at Somerset County ag^t did Marry and take to wife a certain Eliz^t Holland contrary to the promise and affumption ag^t of him the ag^t Wheately Whereupon the said Sarah with she is worse and hath damage to the value of one hundred pounds sterling money and thereupon brings suit ag^t

Copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant in order for a speedy trial. At which day here came the ag^t Sarah Challie by Robert Jenkins Henry her attorney and the sheriff to will John Randy gentl. now here returned that he had taken the ag^t Wheately Dennis whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the ag^t Sarah Challie of the ag^t please to him it was commanded and further the said sheriff returned that he had served the ag^t Wheately Dennis with a copy of the foregoing declaration according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided

Whereupon the ag^t Wheately Dennis being present herein Court at the prayer of the ag^t Sarah Challie adjudged to give speciall bail to the action ag^t

Whereupon a certain John Dennis Jr. of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Wheately Dennis likewise the said Wheately Dennis present herein Court in his proper person assumed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plena^r should be rendered for the same Sarah Challie against the same Wheately Dennis or that the same Wheately Dennis should be therein injict that then he the said Wheately Dennis should pay and satisfy unto the said Sarah Challie the Judgment of the Court thereupon or render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the sherrif of the County ag^t in satisfaction thereof that he the said John Dennis Jr. will do the same for him

And the ag^t Wheately Dennis by his Attorney George Douglas comes and defends the force and Injury when he prayeth leave thereof to Imparle hereuntill next Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August
