One man was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Thomas Pingally late of
Somerset County Bricklayer otherwise called Thomas Pingally of the aforesaid County and province
Bricklayer if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his
body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing first the third Tuesday of
August Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to answer unto Edmund Hough of a plea of that he
render him twenty one pounds currant money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains & on the same
day is given to the vs. Edmund hereby

And the aforesaid Edmund Hough declared against the aforesaid Thomas Pingally in the plea as inform following -
Somerset vs. Thomas Pingally late of Somerset County Bricklayer otherwise called Thomas Pingally of the aforesaid
County and province of Bricklayer was summoned to answer unto Edmund Hough of a plea that he render him
twenty one pounds currant money of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains &

And whereupon the said Edmund by Geo. Douglas his attorney says that whereas the said Thomas
on the xxii day of June Anno Domini MDCXXXVII at the County aforesaid by his certain writing obligatorily which
the said Edmund sealed with the seal of the said Thomas before Court being whose date is the day and year aforesaid
acknowledged himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said Edmund in the sum of twenty one pounds currant money
aforesaid to be paid to the said Edmund when he the said Thomas should thereto be required Nevertheless the said Thomas
the said twenty one pounds to the said Edmund hath not hitherto rendered but that to doe altogether hath denied and
still doth deny and unjustly detain altho' there to afterwards to wit on the first day of November in the year aforesaid at the
Court aforesaid often since that time by the said Edmund required whereupon the said Edmund says he is dammified
forty pounds currant money of Maryland and thereof he brings Suit - {A. P. D. G. C. R. R.}

A copy of the foregoing declaration was made and sent to be served on the defendant in order for a speedy tryall
At which day here came the aforesaid Edmund Hough by George Douglas his attorney and the sheriff to wit John Flanoy
gentl. nowhere returned that he had taken the aforesaid Thomas Pingally whose body he at this day he had ready to
answer the aforesaid Edmund Hough of the aforesaid pleas to him it was commanded and further the said sheriff returning
that he had served the aforesaid Thomas Pingally with a copy of the foregoing declaration according to act of Assembly
