Pidge of the Exchange of the Watches aforesaid of all things to that Exchange relating And that if  
the aforesaid:

one for the other to Exchange should exceed then the said James and Peter the Watches aforesaid to Exchange  
and each of them the said James and Peter his Watch aforesaid to the other of them in Exchange for  
his Watch aforesaid to Deliver and further that if the aforesaid:

any sum of money by either of them the aforesaid James or Peter for that Exchange to either of them to  
be paid by the other should adjudge then the other of the aforesaid James and Peter who any sum of Money  
should be so adjudged upon <sup>his</sup> Occasion to pay unto the other of them that sum according to the same adjudication.
