Therefore by consent of the parties it is considered that the ^{2d} of James Anderson recover against the ^{2d} of Peter Taylor his damages app'd to him as five pounds court money of Maryland by the same Peter in form app'd acknowledged as also three hundred and twelve pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges app'd to the same James at his request by the Court nowhere of the agent of the parties app'd adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to five pounds court money of Maryland and three hundred and twelve pounds of tobacco and the ^{2d} of Peter in mercy

Whereas a certain Mary Riggins being summoned to give security for the balance of her deceased Husband John Riggins Estate according to Law &c and now to wit the Sixteenth day of March anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and forty One came hereinto Court the said Mary Riggins in her proper person and made it appear to the Satisfaction of the same Court that there was no need, nor necessity for her to give any security for the same Balance of estate &c. Whereupon the said Mary Riggins is discharged by the Court from giving any security as aforesaid

Whereupon a certain John Huet Nutter of Somersel County planter being summoned to give security for the balance of a certain Sarah Nutter deceased Estate &c and now to wit the Sixteenth day of March anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and forty One came hereinto Court the said John Huet Nutter and produced the following Certificate to the Worshipfull Justices of Somersel County - I hereby certify that on the Sixth day of January 1744/5 Mr. John Huet Nutter passed his known additional acre on Mrs. Sarah Nutter's Estate by which it appears that he over paid the said Estate the sum of three pounds twelve shillings and four pence - Certified by Henry Troppe Deputy County of Dorchester County - Which being read and heard It is considered that the aforesaid John Huet Nutter be discharged from giving any security for the Balance as transmitted to this Court aforesaid -
