when he said that he cannot deny the action of the said James Anderson nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said James Anderson above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same James by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Peter saith and acknowledgeth that the said James hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to five pounds current money of the province of Maryland and not more and because the said James deny not this but the same allegation grants to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges of to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by consent of the parties it is considered that the said James Anderson recover against the said Peter Taylor his damages of to the said five pounds current money of Maryland by the same Peter in form of acknowledged as also three hundred and twelve pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges of to the same James at his request by the Court now here of the absent of the parties of adjudged which certain damages in the whole amounts to five pounds current money of Maryland and three hundred and twelve pounds of tobacco and the said Peter in mercy &c

Whereas a certain Mary Biggini being Summored to give Security for the Balance of her deceased Husband John Biggini's Estate according to Law &c and now to wit the Sixteenth day of March and Done One thousand Seven hundred and forty One came here into Court the said Mary Biggini in her proper person and made it appear to the Satisfaction of the same Court that there was no need, nor necessity for her to give any Security for the same Balance of Estate of &c. Whereupon the said Mary Biggini is discharged by the Court from giving any Security as aforesaid &c

Whereupon a certain John Hewitt Nutter of Somerset County planter being Summored to give Security for the balance of a certain Sarah Nutter deceased's Estate &c and now to wit the Sixteenth day of March and Done One thousand Seven hundred and forty One came here into Court the said John Hewitt Nutter and produced the following Certificate &c
To the Worshipful Justices of Somerset County - I hereby Certifie that on the Sixth day of January 1741/2 Mr. John Hewitt Nutter passed his second additional Acc^t on M^{rs} Sarah Nutter's Estate by which it appears that he over paid the said Estate the sum of three pounds twelve shillings and four pence - Certified of Henry Trippe deputy Comy of Dorchester County - - - Which being read and heard It is considered that the aforesaid John Hewitt Nutter be discharged from giving any Security for the Balance as Transmitted to this Court &c aforesaid -
