Ordered that Angelo Alkinson recover against Whittington King one hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco being due unto him for his Attendance ^{as an evidence} five days on behalf of the said Whittington King against Finch Jones he having made oath to the same &c

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Arthur Warwick if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to satisfy William Pilschard of one hundred and Eighty Six pounds of tobacco which to the same William in his Lordships County Court of Somerset before the Justices thereof at dividing Creek by discretion of the same our Justices were adjudged for his Costs and Charges which he sustained in a certain plea of trespass upon the Case by the said Arthur Warwick against the same William Pilschard in the same Court Impetrate according to the form of the statute thereof made and provided against parties plaintiffs which their writs in such manner of plead doe not prosecute or in the same should be precluded whereof he is convicted &c and the same day is given to the said William her &c

At which day here came the said William Pilschard in his proper person and the sheriff (to wit) John Standy Gent. at the same day nowhere returned that he had taken the said Arthur Warwick whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the said William of the Costs of as to him it was commanded &c

Command was given to the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Heber Whittingham late of Somerset County gentleman if he should be found in his bailiwick and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at dividing Creek the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty one to satisfy Comfort Jenkinson of thirteen pounds ten shillings and seven pence Curr^t money and twelve hundred and Eighteen pounds of tobacco which to the same Comfort Jenkinson in the same Court before his Lordships Justices at dividing Creek were adjudged for his Damages which he had by occasion of a certain promise.
