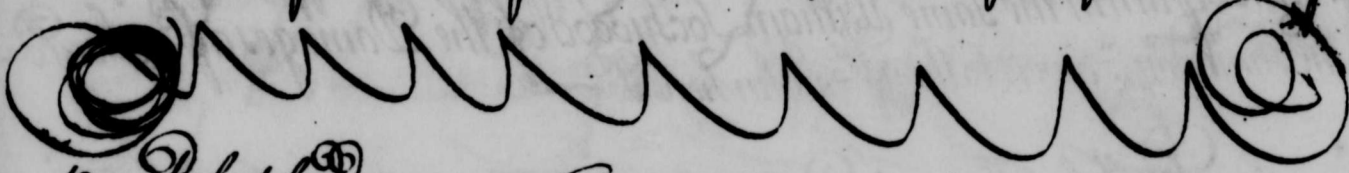


for Levin Gale Esq^r

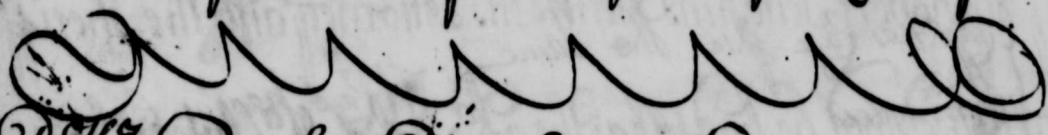
