The same Peter beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in this part apposed to ten pounds current money  
of Maryland and for those costs and charges to one pound of tobacco --

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Peter Taylor recover against the aforesaid Womrey --  
McLennan his damages aforesaid by the sum aforesaid in form aforesaid apayed as also One Thousand One hundred &  
Twenty eight pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges to the same Peter Taylor by the Court here affixed of America  
adjudged which certain damages in the whole amount to Ten pounds curr. money of Maryland and One Thousand One hundred  
and Twenty nine -- pounds of tobacco and the aforesaid Womrey in money the aforesaid in the place before reserved  
unto the aforesaid defendant the aforesaid Ten pounds curr. money of Maryland and One Thousand One hundred and Twenty  
nine pounds of tobacco and Therefore the said Womrey McLennan of the aforesaid Ten pounds curr. money and One  
Thousand One hundred and Twenty nine pounds of tobacco be quiet etc.
