so aforesaid Impartially being called over by their names to appear as above and were sworn and charged  
and sent out to consider the soon after the Jurors aforesaid being sworn and charged as aforesaid return here  
into Court and present to the Court here present appearance against a certain Sarah Houchen and  
thereupon the Jurors aforesaid were accordingly discharged and against the aforesaid Sarah Houchen It is ordered  
that a Special Issue Returnable to August Court there next following be
