his during the term aforesaid

In consideration of which Service the said George Cifton present heron Court in
his proper person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in Court Individually sitting in manner and form follow-
ing that is to say that he the said George Cifton J^r shall and will during the Term aforesaid Learn his said apprentice
the Trade of a house Carpenter and give him six months Schooling and Likewise provide for his said apprentice meat
drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid

Covenants aforesaid Thereupon the said George Cifton J^r with aforesaid John Goddard of Somerset County

or Chattels Lands or Tenements jointly or severally to be made and Levied to the Use of the said Michael
Cifton his his Executors administrators or assigns In Case the said George Cifton J^r doe not during the
Term aforesaid Learn his said apprentice the Trade of a house Carpenter, and do not give him six months
Schooling, and doe not provide for his said apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Cloathing sufficient
for such an apprentice to have and wear during the term aforesaid &c
