Whereupon the aforesaid John Gale together with Levin Gale and George Gale both of Somerset County Esquires his Security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the aforesaid Christopher Nutter Orphan as aforesaid in Seven hundred and forty three pounds ten Shillings Current money of Maryland of their bodies goods or Chattles Lands or tenements Severally to the Use of the aforesaid Christopher Nutter Orphan as aforesaid his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to be made and Levied If it happen that the aforesaid John Gale Guardian as aforesaid ^{do not Comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship as is} and do not deliver up unto the aforesaid Orphan, or his Guardian all his Estate both Real and personall, that he shall receive and take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same should be Legally required &c

The same Guardian to Ann Nutter.

John Gale of Somerset County Gentleman being present herein Court in his proper person of his own free Consent is appointed by the Court here as Guardian in and

over Ann Nutter an Orphan under the age of fourteen years untill the said Orphan should arrive at full age for the Choosing of her Guardian &c Thereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that a certain George Hardy who had Intermarried with the mother of the aforesaid Orphan deliver up unto the aforesaid Guardian all the Estate of the aforesaid Orphan that he hath in his hands and possession both real and personall and that the aforesaid Guardian receive the same and give good security for to Comply with the Guardianship aforesaid

Whereupon the aforesaid John Gale together with Levin Gale and George Gale both of Somerset County Esquires his security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the aforesaid Ann Nutter Orphan in five hundred and forty four pounds five shillings and six pence Curr^t money of Maryland of their bodies goods or Chattles Lands or tenements severally to the use of the aforesaid Ann Nutter Orphan as aforesaid her heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to be made and Levied If it happen that the aforesaid John Gale Guardian as aforesaid ^{do not Comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship as is} and do not deliver up unto the aforesaid Orphan or his Guardian all his Estate both real and personall that he shall receive and take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly when ever the same should be Legally required &c
