WHEREON the aforesaid John Gale together with Lewis Gale and George Gale both of Somerset
County Esquires his Deputies all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the
aforesaid Christopher Nutter Orphan as aforesaid in Seven hundred and forty three pounds ten Shillings Current money
of Maryland of their bodies goods or chattels Lands or tenements severally to the use of the aforesaid Christopher
Nutter Orphan as aforesaid in his heires Administrators or assigns to be made and levied If it happen that the
aforesaid John Gale do not comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship as is and
doe not deliver up unto the aforesaid Orphan, or his Guardian
all his Estate both Real and personall that he shall receive and take into his hands and possession, peaceably and
quietly whenever the same should be Legally required &c

John Gale of Somerset County Gentleman being present here in Court in his pro-
perty of his own free lensor is appointed by the Court here as Guardian in and
out of Ann Nutter and Orphan under the age of fourteen years untill the said Orphan should arrive at
full age for the Chasing of her Guardian &c Thereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that a certain George Hardy who
had intermaried with the mother of the aforesaid Orphan deliver up unto the aforesaid Guardian all his Estate of the aforesaid Orphan that
he hath in his hands and possession both real and personall and that the aforesaid Guardian receive the same and give good security
for to comply with the guardianship aforesaid

Whereupon the aforesaid John Gale together with Lewis Gale and George Gale both of Somerset County Esquires his security
all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the aforesaid Ann Nutter Orphan aforesaid in five
hundred and forty four pounds five shillings and six pence Current money of Maryland of their bodies goods or chattels Lands or tenements
severally to the use of the aforesaid Ann Nutter Orphan as aforesaid in his heires Administrators or assigns to be made and levied If it happen
that the aforesaid John Gale do not comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship as is and
doe not deliver up unto the aforesaid Orphan or his Guardian all his Estate both real and
personall that he shall receive and take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly whenever the same should be Legally
required &c
