To the Worshipfull Justices of Somerset County now sitting the Humble petition of Thomas Bannister and John Griffen humbly sheweth that we the subscribers have long stood security for the estate of William Haith for Ann Haith at Dublin his dec<sup>d</sup> wife we pray that she may give counter security or deliver up the Estate for we understand she is going to move out of the County or deliver it up into the hands of your humble petitioners which is in duty bound to pray

The petition aforesaid being read and heard and fully understood and mature deliberation

It is considered by the Court that the aforesaid Ann Haith at Dublin deliver up unto the aforesaid Thomas Bannister and John Griffen all the Estate of the aforesaid Willm Haith dec<sup>d</sup> that she hath in her hands and possession that doth belong to the Legate Representative of the aforesaid Willm Haith dec<sup>d</sup> or give them counter security according to act of Assembly in such case made and provided otherwise attachment or distress upon application will issue out of this Court against the Estate as aforesaid to possess themselves thereof

the peace in the County aforesaid being a signed by the Bill of Indictment presented that Elizabeth Porter late of Somerset County parish in the County of Somerset spinster the nineteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty one at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain person to the damage of unknown and did permit the same unknown person thereto have carnal knowledge of her body and then and there to beget a bastard child on the body of her the same Elizabeth Porter to the high displeasure of Almighty God to the evill example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his good rule and government and against the reformation of the
