



Court here fully understood it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Shelah Dougher pay unto his said Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary for her service by the Court here upon her Imposed for and by reason of the premises aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid she is bound Thirly Pounds Current money of Maryland and that the said Shelah be Taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of her service aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Shelah is Ordered to give Security to have and keep Indemnified the Justices of the County of Somerset and their Successors from all trouble burdens Costs and Charges that might arisue by means of the birth maintenance and bringing up of the Child aforesaid &c.

Whereupon after this Thomas Toadornie of Somerset County planter present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the same Shelah Dougher and acknowledged himself Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in Thirly pounds Current money of said Province of his body goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to be made and Levied to the use of the Inhabitants of the County of Somerset for the time being If it happen that the said Thomas Toadornie his heirs Executors or Administrators or any or either of them doe not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and Satisfie as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being as also the Inhabitants of said County of and from all costs Charges and Burthen whatsoever for or by Reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and bringing up of the aforesaid Child and of and from all other such Charges Troubles or demands whatsoever for holding or concerning of the same &c — Likewise the said Shelah Dougher is Ordered to give Security for the payment of all fee or fees due by means of the information aforesaid to any person or persons whatsoever

Whereupon the aforesaid Thomas Toadornie present here in Court undertook for the said Shelah Dougher to pay all fee or fees due to any person or persons on the information aforesaid In case the said Shelah Dougher doth not pay the same &c



Edward Bennett. Now to witt this eighteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and forty Two discharged from Lewes at about their Field about Duxbury Creek before his Lordships Justices came the aforesaid Edward Bennett in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security in this part before acknowledged and pray that his appearance may be recorded and he and his Security discharged from the Recognizance aforesaid &c. Whereupon the said Edward Bennett appearance is recorded and he and his Security accordingly discharged from the Recognizance aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Edward Bennett is Ordered to give Security for the payment of all fee or fees due to any person or persons on the Recognizance aforesaid &c

Whereupon after this Joshua Mitchell present here in Court in his proper person undertook for the said Edward Bennett to pay all fee or fees due to any person or persons on the Recognizance aforesaid In case the said Edward Bennett doth not pay the same &c
