Thomas Walker of Somerset County, Inholder came here into Court in his proper person and Recognizance — and Prays that he may be permitted to keep an Ordinary or house of Entertainment at his dwelling house at Windaromow River in the County for the Use and Convenience of the Inhabitants Travellers and Strangers as to them Respectively shall seem meet which is here unto him by the Court granted &c. he giving security to Comply with the act of Assembly in such Case made and provided &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Walker with Mathias Gale of the County of Esq. and William Jones of the same place gave his securitys at present here in Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves — Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland in the full and Just sum of five pounds Current money of said province of their bodys Goods or Chattels Funds or Tenements severally to be made and Leised to the Use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors. If it happen that the said Thomas Walker doe not pay and satisfy unto the Sheriff of the County afo for the time being — fifty Shillings Current money of the province afo yearly and Every Year he shall keep such Ordinary or house of Entertainment as aforesaid &c.
