The Court here that the said William Copsey pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court hereupon him imposed for and by occasion of the premises of £10 hereof in form of his Condict thirty shillings Curr: money of Maryland and that the said William Copsey be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine of £23

Whereupon the said William Copsey is ordered to give security to save and keep indemnified the Justices of the County of Somerset and their Successors from all troubles burthens and Charges that might accrue by means of the birth maintainance and bringing up of the Child of £23

Thereupon the said William Copsey with Joseph Porter of Somerset County planter his security both present herein Court in his proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordship the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in Forty pounds Curr: money of their bodies goods or Chattles Lands or tenements normally to be made and levied to the use of the Inhabitants of the County of Somerset for the time being if it happen that the said William Copsey and Joseph Porter their heirs Executors or Assigns any or either of them doe not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being as also the Inhabitants of said County of and from all Costs Charges and burthens whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintainance nourishing and bringing up of the Child of £23 and of and from all other suits Charges troubles or demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same

Whereupon the said William Copsey is ordered to give good security for the payment of all fees or fines due on the Information of £2 to any person or person whatsoever. Thereupon Joseph Porter of Somerset County planter present herein Court undertook for the said William Copsey to pay all fees or fines due to any person or persons whatsoever on the Information of £2 in case the said William Copsey doth not pay the same



James Quaternus appears herein Court according to his Recognizance Entered into for his appearance at this Court to answer unto all such matters and things as should be Objected against him on his Lordship's behalf as to give evidence against a certain Nicholas Buidler on Suspicion of felony &c. and is discharged from said Recognizance he paying the Several Officers fees due thereon
