The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissary Gentl^l hath transmitted unto this Court the Account of the estate of James Rownd dec^d wherein it is found that there is ballance due to the above said Orphans the sum of five hundred and thirty three pounds five shillings and eleven pence farthing Curr^t money therefore if the above said Katherine Rownd James Martin and John Miller their or any of their heirs Ex^{ors} or Adm^{ors} shall and doe well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above said Orphans the sum of five hundred and thirty three pounds five shilling and eleven pence half penny Curr^t money According to Act of Assembly and the deceased will when shall arrive at full age to receive the same. & then the above obligation to be void and of none effect or otherwise to remain in full force and virtue &
